GRAND FORKS PUBLIC SCHOOLS



SAPC provided financial support to Grand Forks Public Schools to implement **Too Good for Drugs,** a universal K-12

prevention education program designed to mitigate the risk factors and enhance protective factors related to alcohol, tobacco, and other drug use. The lessons introduce and develop social and emotional skills for making healthy choices, building positive friendships, developing self-efficacy, communicating effectively, and resisting peer pressure and influence.



SAPC provided financial support to Grand Forks Public Schools to employ 3rd Millennium Classrooms which offers online

prevention and intervention courses for students, teachers, and parents addressing substance use, shoplifting, and interpersonal violence.

PARENTS LEAD

SAPC promotes **Parents Lead**, an evidence-based prevention program that provides parents and caregivers with a wide variety of tools and resources to support them in creating a safe environment for their children that promotes behavioral health.

Parents Lead believes the parent-child relationship is essential to the development and well-being of children. In fact, healthy bonding and attachment between parent and child is one of the

biggest factors preventing behavioral health issues like underage drinking, drug use, depression, and anxiety.





LUTHERAN SOCIAL SERVICES OF NORTH DAKOTA

SAPC provided funding to Lutheran Social Services to support **DIVERT** (Discovering

Integrating Voluntary Effective Resolutions Together). Divert Therapy Services counsels families with at-risk youth (ages 6-17) to prevent court involvement and keep families together while helping the youth develop skills and healthy activities.

SAPC provided funding to local law enforcement agencies to support **TIP411**, a web-based toolset for law enforcement that features anonymous text tips, group alerting and secure social media publishing tools. TIP411 helps law enforcement agencies engage community members by enabling anyone with a cell phone to text anonymous tips that can be responded to in real time by authorized personnel in the agency.
